10. UNIDADES TEMÁTICAS, CONTENIDOS, BIBLIOGRAFÍA POR UNIDAD TEMÁTICA:

- **UNIT 1:**

SPEAKING: Alphabet. Numbers. Colours. What's your name? Countries and nationalities.

GRAMMAR: Simple Present: verb to be. Affirmative (subject + verb). Negative (subject + auxiliar + not + verb). Interrogative (aux + subject + verb). Articles: definite (the). Indefinite (a- an).

WRITING- READING: Translation of a passage: "Temporary Winter Pastures" lexical and structural analysis of the text.
